SUBJECT	<i>ALS Protocol Medication Infusions</i>

PURPOSE

The removal of the 15 gtt set and the “Dial-a-Flow” from the Medication Infusion chart. Approved is the following:

- 1000 mL bag of normal saline and a 10 gtt set for the administration of Epinephrine and Norepinephrine drips
- 100 mL bag of normal saline and a 60 gtt set for the administration of Lidocaine drips
- 100 mL bag of normal saline and a 10 gtt set for the administration of Magnesium drips

LIMITATIONS

For use by MidState Critical Care Technicians and Paramedics when working within the MidState Region.

EXPECTATIONS

The use of a “Dial-a-Flow” or a 15 gtt set is not allowed for prehospital medication infusions by the MidState Region.
